NOTE TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

March 31, 2021

1. Canada Emergency Business Account Loan

The Canada Emergency Business Account (CEBA) is a \$40,000 loan that was extended to organizations to assist with operational costs during the pandemic. The value of the loan accepted by the Association was \$40,000. If the loan is paid in full by December 31, 2022, the loan will not bear interest and \$10,000 of the loan will be forgiven.

The Association has committed to pay \$20,000 of the outstanding amount by December 31, 2021.
